- 6. The Clydesdales feature in Bothy ballads. Do you know any bothy ballads?
- 7. Aberdeen city used to have Clydesdales working in the city. Would you like to see Clydesdales working in your city. What jobs could they do?
- 8. Can you think of other animals that work with their handler today?
- 9. The horseman and his Clydesdales used to walk eleven miles each day when ploughing. What was the longest walk you did in a day?
- 10. Are there any farms close to you where you could see and meet Clydesdales?
